ADDENDUM NO. 1 TO HEB PHARMACY CONTRACT TO ADMINISTER IMMUNIZATIONS FOR WILLIAMSON COUNTY (FY2015)

The underlying HEB Pharmacy Contract To Administer Immunications For Williamson County for FY2015 (the "Contract"), between HEB Grocery Company, LP ("HEB") and Williamson County, Texas ("County") is amended as specifically set forth herein to incorporate the terms and conditions of this Addendum No. 1. As amended, the Contract shall remain in full force and effect according to its terms and conditions. All terms used in this Addendum No. 1 shall have the meanings attributed to them in the Contract. This Addendum No. 1 supersedes any and all prior understandings and agreements, oral or written, relating to the subject matter. In the event there is a conflict between the terms and conditions of the Contract and the terms and conditions of this Addendum No. 1 shall control:

- 1. Venue and Governing Law. Each party to this Contract hereby agrees and acknowledges that venue and jurisdiction of any suit, right, or cause of action arising out of or in connection with this Contract shall lie exclusively in Williamson County, Texas, and the parties hereto expressly consent and submit to such jurisdiction. Furthermore, except to the extent that this Contract is governed by the laws of the United States, this Contract shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, excluding, however, its choice of law rules.
- 2. No Waiver of Immunities. Nothing in this Contract shall be defined to waive, modify or amend any legal defense available at law or in equity to County, its past or present officers, employees, or agents, nor to create any legal rights or claim on behalf of any third party. County does not waive, modify, or alter to any extent whatsoever the availability of the defense of governmental immunity under the laws of the State of Texas and of the United States.
- 3. County's Right to Audit. HEB agrees that County or its duly suthorized representatives shall, until the expiration of three (3) years after final payment under this Contract, have access to and the right to examine and photocopy any and all books, documents, papers and records of HEB which are directly pertinent to the services to be performed under this Contract for the purposes of making audits, examinations, excerpts, and transcriptions. HEB agrees that County shall have access during normal working hours to all necessary HEB facilities and shall be provided adequate and appropriate work space in order to conduct audits in compliance with the provisions of this section. County shall give HEB reasonable advance notice of intended audits.
- 4. Non-Appropriation and Fiscal Funding. The obligations of the County under this Contract do not constitute a general obligation or indebtedness of County for which County is obligated to levy, pledge, or collect any form of taxation. It is understood and agreed that County shall have the right to terminate this Contract at the end of any County fiscal year if

officers and employees shall have no liability or obligation to any party hereto for the disclosure to the public, or to any person or persons, of any items of data furnished to County by a party hereto, in reliance of any advice, decision or opinion of the Attorney General of the State of Texas.

- 9. Execution in Counterparts. This Contract may be executed in counterparts, each of which, when executed and delivered, shall be deemed to be an original and all of which together shall constitute one and the same document.
- 10. Successors and Assigns. This Contract shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.
