WHEREAS, the victims and survivors of crimes and their families and victims families by all means possible to bring attention to the victims and their families and

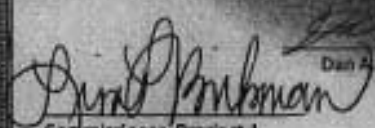

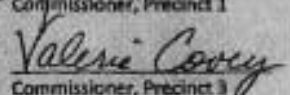
NOW THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Williamson County, State of Texas, do hereby proclaim the

and urges the citizens of Williamson County, Texas, to observe the event on Tuesday December 2nd, 2014.

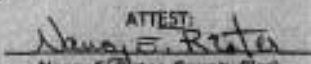
