## RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF WILLIAMSON COUNTY, TEXAS REQUESTING THAT THE WILLIAMSON CENTRAL APPRAISAL DISTRICT REAPPRAISE PROPERTIES AFFECTED BY THE RECENT 2015 SEVERE WEATHER, DEVASTATING TORNADOS AND HISTORIC FLOODING, AS AUTHORIZED BY TEXAS TAX CODE SECTION 23.02.

## RECITALS:

WHEREAS, areas of Williamson County, Texas suffered widespread severe property damage and injuries resulting from severe weather, devastating tornados and historic floods that occurred from May 4, 2015 through June 19, 2015;

WHEREAS, Governor Greg Abbott, in accordance with the authority vested in him by Sections 418.014 through 418.017 of the Texas Disaster Act, issued Emergency Disaster Proclamations on May 11, May 15, May 25, May 26, May 29, June 3, June 18, June 22 and July 22, 2015, certifying that the severe weather, tornado and flooding event that began on May 4, 2015, has caused a disaster in many Texas counties and that such disaster conditions persist in many parts of the state including Williamson County;

WHEREAS, the Williamson County Commissioners Court desires to request that the Williamson Central Appraisal District reappraise property damaged by the disaster as authorized by Texas Tax Code Section 23.02; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WILLIAMSON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT:

PART 1. The Williamson County Commissioners Court requests that the Williamson Central Appraisal District reappraise property within areas of Williamson County, Texas that was damaged by the disaster as soon as practicable.

PART 2. Beginning on the date of the disaster, May 4, 2015, and continuing through the remainder of 2015, Williamson County will apply its tax rate to the reappraised market value of the properties that are reappraised by the Williamson Central Appraisal District.
