

**ORDER ADJUSTING THE BOUNDARY BETWEEN
WILLIAMSON COUNTY ELECTION PRECINCTS 273, 277, AND 278**

Precinct 278 has 5,047 active registered voters. Precinct 278 violates section 42.006 of the Texas Election Code because it contains more than 5,000 registered voters. Section 42.031(b)(2) of the Texas Election Code grants Commissioners Court the authority to make necessary changes in the precinct boundary.

The precincts affected by the boundary adjustments are 277, 278, and 273 and graphically shown in the map described as Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein. The changes will result in the following active registered voter counts:

Precinct 273	2,671
Precinct 277	4,701
Precinct 278	4,584

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that, effective January 1, 2018:

Precinct 273 will gain the southern portion of current Precinct 277, south of Cypress Creek Road. The designated polling place for Precinct 207 shall be Cedar Park High School, 2150 Cypress Creek Road, Cedar Park.

Precinct 277 will gain the southern portion of current Precinct 278, south of Buttercup Creek. The designated polling place for Precinct 277 shall be Westside Elementary School, 2150 Cypress Creek Road, 300 Ryan Jordan Lane, Cedar Park.

**Election Precinct No. 273
Williamson County, Texas**

BEGINNING at the intersection of Cypress Creek Road and the common line between Williamson and Travis County;

Thence, easterly, along the center of Cypress Creek Road to its intersection with Sun Chase Boulevard;

Thence, southerly, along the center of Sun Chase Boulevard to its intersection with Old Mill Road;

Thence, southerly, along the center of Old Mill Road to its intersection with Aster Pass;

Thence, southerly, along the center of Aster Pass to its intersection with Mesquite Road;

Thence, easterly, along the center of Mesquite Road to its intersection with Little Elm Trail;

Thence, southerly, along the center of Little Elm Trail to its intersection with North Farm-to-Market Road 620;

Thence, westerly, along the center of North Farm-to-Market Road 620 to its intersection with the common line between Williamson and Travis Counties.

EXHIBIT C

**Election Precinct No. 277
Williamson County, Texas**

**BEGINNING at the intersection of West Whitestone Boulevard and the common line between
Williamson and Travis County;**

**THENCE, easterly, along the center of West Whitestone Boulevard to its intersection with the center of
North Lakeline Boulevard;**

THENCE, southerly, along the center of North Lakeline Boulevard to South Lakeline Boulevard;

**THENCE, southerly, along the center of South Lakeline Boulevard to its intersection with Buttercup
Creek;**

THENCE, southerly, along the center of Buttercup Creek to its intersection with the Cypress Creek Road;

**THENCE, westerly, along the center of Cypress Creek Boulevard to its intersection with the common line
between Williamson and Travis Counties.**

EXHIBIT D

**Election Precinct No. 278
Williamson County, Texas**

BEGINNING at the intersection of Lakeline Boulevard and West Park Street;

THENCE, easterly, along the center of West Park Street to its intersection with Old US Highway 183;

THENCE, southerly, along the center of Old US Highway 183 to South Bell Boulevard;

THENCE, southerly, along the center of South Bell Boulevard to its intersection with Cypress Creek Road;

THENCE, westerly, along the center of Cypress Creek road to its intersection with Buttercup Creek;

THENCE, westerly, along the center of Buttercup Creek to its intersection with South Lakeline Boulevard;

THENCE, northerly, along the center of South Lakeline Boulevard to its intersection with West Park Street and the place of the BEGINNING.
