




FY18 FUNDING PRIORITIES

 - Increase operational readiness and coordination
 - Public Outreach and Education
 - Volunteer Program Coordination
 - Hazard Mitigation Planning and Grants Acquisition
 - Pre / Post Disaster Mitigation
 - Residential Hazard Mitigation Programs
 - Continue / Increase the level of site specific planning by hazard
- Positions Requested ~\$150,000
 - Sr. EM Specialist
 - EM Analyst
