

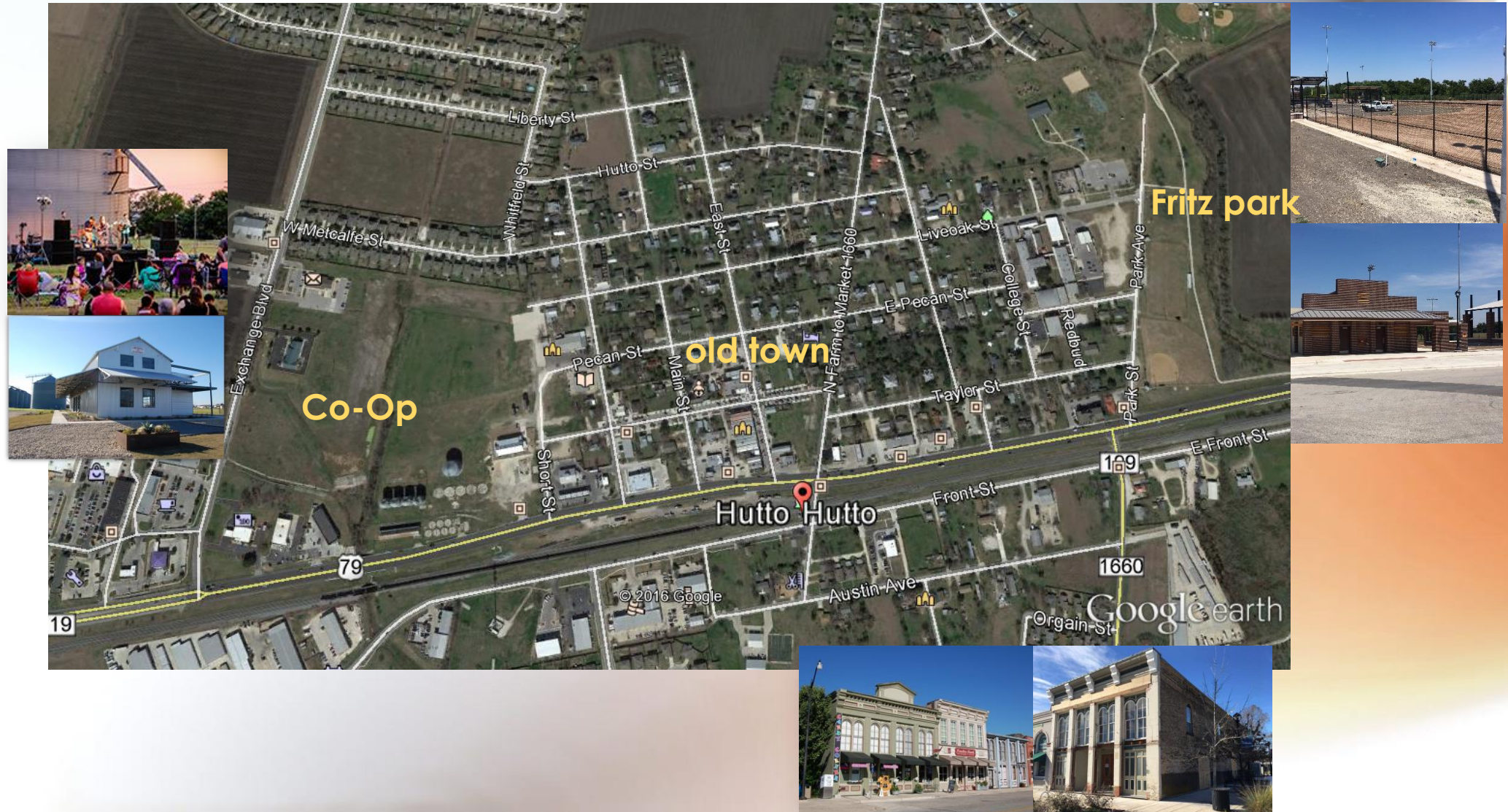

- Adjacent to county property



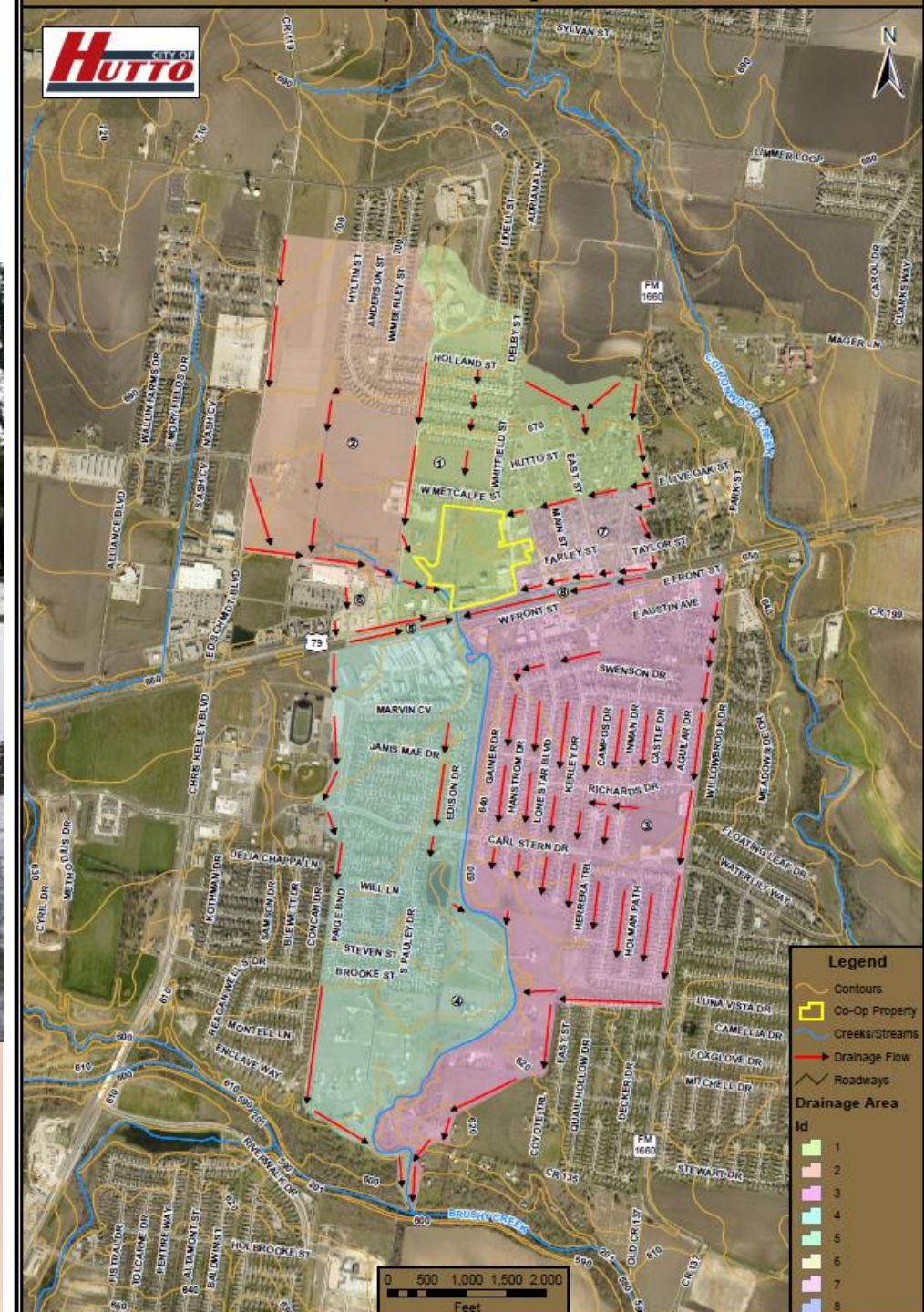

# Drainage solutions

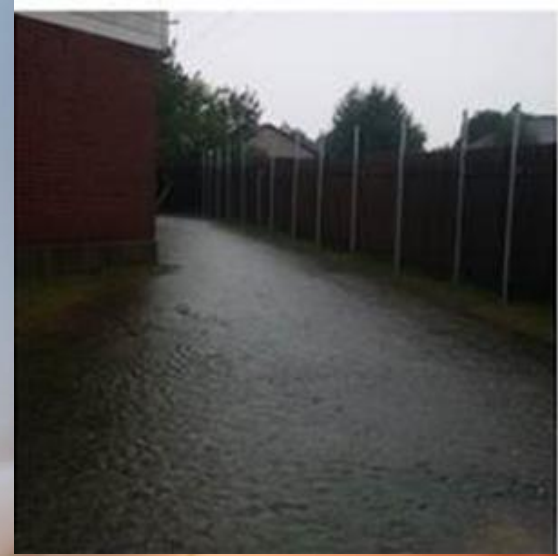


## Challenges:
