ORDER ADOPTING A TAX RATE FOR TAX YEAR 2017

WHEREAS, Vernon's Texas Codes Annotated (V.T.C.A.) Tax Code 26.05 provides that the Williamson County Commissioners Court shall adopt the tax rates for the current year; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to levy ad valorem taxes on each \$100 valuation of all taxable property in Williamson County, Texas for the Tax Year beginning January 1, 2017, which will be due no later than January 31, 2018 at the tax rates set forth herein below; and

WHEREAS, the Williamson County Commissioners Court has complied with all the requirements set forth in the Tax Code; NOW

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Williamson County Commissioners Court hereby adopts the following tax rates:

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S RATE; and

THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 0.74 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$1.92.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the Williamson County Commissioners Court levy taxes in accordance with the foregoing tax rates and the provisions of the law.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that if for any reason, the action of the Williamson County Commissioners Court setting tax rates or levying taxes should be held ineffective by a court of

competent jurisdiction, that this Order shall serve as evidence of the good faith of Williamson County in attempting to comply with the law in as substantial a fashion as could be done under the circumstances, and as evidence that Williamson County would have lawfully adopted a tax rate but for the conditions completely beyond control of Williamson County.
