

Landfill Gas Collection Improvements 2017

- Installed nine vertical landfill gas extraction wells
- Installed one horizontal landfill gas collector
- Installed an 18 inch header pipe along north and west portion of landfill
- Landfill currently has 62 gas extraction wells



Planned Improvements

- Construct next disposal cell
- Construct new internal road to access next disposal area
- Add landfill gas extraction wells, as needed
- Replace/Upgrade Inbound scale




