
**WHEREAS**, The Locker was created in 2008 by a group of student athletes that wanted to be more than just athletes in their community; and


**WHEREAS**, The Locker “educates and empowers youth, through Service Learning, to meet the needs of others in their community so that every child has a sense of normalcy”; and


