This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU"), effective on the 1st day of September, 2018, between Williamson County EMS and T. Don Hutto Residential Center (TDHRC) provides confirmation and adequate assurance of mutual cooperation and assistance as well as identifies available services to be provide by each party to the other upon reasonable request pursuant to usual procedures and policies. Currently, TDHRC houses female residents for U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement.

DESCRIPTION OF BASIC SERVICES

1. TDHRC will notify Williamson County EMS of any incident that may require immediate medical transportation;
2. In the event of an emergency situation (e.g., natural disaster, etc.) where medical transportation would be required, TDHRC will request assistance from Williamson County EMS as appropriate; and
3. TDHRC will notify Williamson County EMS of any incident that requires specialized clinical support from the Williamson County Tactical Medical Team.

UNDERSTANDING OF THE PARTIES

This MOU shall commence on the above date and continue for a period of one year or until modified by both parties or terminated by either party.

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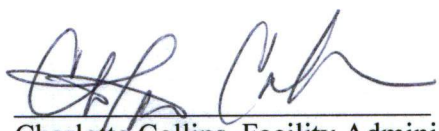
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
