
WHEREAS, the Williamson County Commissioners' Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Williamson County, that the Radiological Detection Sustainment Project Grant Application be submitted to the State of Texas, Office of the Governor; and

WHEREAS, the Williamson County Commissioners' Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) – State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) funds, the Williamson County Commissioners' Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) – State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) in full; and

WHEREAS, the Williamson County Commissioners' Court designates the Honorable Bill Gravell Jr., Williamson County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Williamson County Commissioners' Court approves submission of the grant application to the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) – State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) for the Williamson County Fluorine Detector and Related Equipment project.
