Where, among other matters, came up for consideration and adoption the following Resolution:

Whereas, the Williamson County Commissioners Court finds it is in the best interest of the citizens of Williamson County, that Williamson County Juvenile Services accept funding for the General Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Program Grant, Trauma Focused Equine-Assisted Therapy for Justice Involved Youth, Grant Number 3816601; and

Whereas, the Williamson County Commissioners Court has considered the proposed application for State and Federal Assistance for said project, in the amount of \$65,400.00 to be submitted to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, Fund JJDP Program; and

Whereas, the Williamson County Commissioners Court agrees in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the Williamson County Commissioners Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and

Whereas, the Williamson County Commissioners Court has agreed that a designation of the title of an authorized official who is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant is hereby identified as the Williamson County Judge.

Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Williamson County Commissioners Court approves submission of the grant application for the General Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Program, Trauma Focused Equine-Assisted Therapy for Justice Involved Youth, Grant Number 3816601, to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.

The foregoing Resolution was lawfully moved by Judge Bill Gravell Jr., duly seconded by Commissioner Terry Cook, and duly adopted by the Williamson County Commissioners Court on a vote of 3 members for the motion and 0 opposed.
