#### Change Order No. 4

#### **Reason for Change**

This Change Order compensates the Contractor for the labor and equipment cost to repair flexible base on the west roadway approach due to a water line break on Remuda Drive on 1/31/2020. The flexible base passed density testing on 1/30/2020 and had to be reprocessed after being saturated by the water leak. The water line break was not caused by the Contractor.

Following is a summary of the new item required for this Change Order.

This Change Order results in an increase of \$10,233.46 to the Contract amount, for an adjusted Contract total of \$1,460,316.27. The original Contract amount was \$1,425,301.90. Because of this and all other Change Orders, \$35,014.37 has been added to the Contract, resulting in a 2.46% net increase in the Contract cost. No additional days will be added to or deducted from the Contract as a result of this Change Order.








