Reason for Change

This Change Order adds work to prevent bats from nesting under the Great Oaks Bridge over Brushy Creek. This work is being added to the project so that the Great Oaks bridge replacement project can bid and begin work this winter. The total cost includes the subcontractor cost plus 15% markup to cover costs and 1% markup to pay for the bond for the prime contractor.

Bat Exclusion: Brushy Creek Bridge

1. Set-up work zone using barricades such as A-frames, orange cones and caution tape. As required by HNTB Corp., signage will be posted at project site.

Note: Access will be gained via scaffolding placed in river as needed.

- **2.** Mechanically fasten 1/4" x 1/4" galvanized hardware cloth to underside of Brushy Creek Bridge at seven (7) expansion joints, each running approximately 115' long, as well as at the vertical joints at column supports, as a means of excluding the existing roosting bats.
- **3**. As hardware cloth is being installed, we will also install tube bat exclusion devices at the main bat entry/exit points to allow for roosting bats to leave the roost.

These exclusion devices will be left up until bat have successfully excluded (approx 5-7 days depending on the weather).

4. Return to remove bat excluders and complete seal using additional pieces of mechanically fastened 1/4" x 1/4" galvanized hardware cloth.

Roosting bat colonies may sometimes relocate in between the time a bid is submitted and the work begins. When this occurs the bat excluders are not always deemed a necessary step, however if bats are present, excluders will be installed.

* Due to the nature of wildlife control, the project price is subject to change orders as bats may relocate unexpectedly, such as in the lowest part of that bridge (not covered in scope due to the unlikely roost choice) which would be unlikely. This price is also subject to change depending on exclusion method and material approvals, etc.
