School Information

- Williamson County school districts were allocated \$5.7 million in funding through the CARES Act that was directed through TEA
- School districts will receive zero net dollars as a result of the state's allocation and distribution methods
- Needs of schools (public, charter, and private) have varied greatly depending on size, location, economic status, previous focus on technology, etc.
- It appears, in general, schools have spent somewhere above \$200 per student in unreimbursed expenses preparing for the current school year
- There are somewhere between 130,000-150,000 students in Williamson County school districts, charter schools, and private schools.
