#### Change Order No. 3

#### **Reason for Change**

This Change Order adds an item for additional potholing needed to locate City of Austin (COA) water line facilities not called for in the plans and outside the scope of the existing bid items. In addition, this Change Order adds an item to reimburse for mailboxes that are not shown in the plans but need to be removed and replaced due to the COA water line relocations.

Item 510-6001 MAILBOX REMOVE AND REPLACE-S (TWG-POST) TY 1 is an existing bid item in the County portion of the contract. This change order adds the item to the items paid for by the COA. The City of Austin has agreed to pay the additional costs associated with these items. The use of these items will be directed by the City of Austin inspector assigned to the project.

The following new items will be added by this Change Order.

This Change Order results in a net increase of \$27,841.45 to the Contract amount, for an adjusted Contract total of \$4,848,270.52. The original Contract amount was \$4,793,058.15. As a result of this and all Change Orders to-date, \$55,212.37 has been added to the Contract, resulting in a 1.15% net increase in the overall Contract cost. No time will be added to the Contract for this Change Order. Austin Water Utilities has reviewed and approved these changes and pricing.

This Change Order is for water line changes that are part of the COA-funded portion of the Contract. This Change Order is a net increase of \$27,841.45 for an adjusted City Contract amount of \$1,812,761.45. The original water line portion of the Contract was \$1,762,567.00. The \$50,097.23 increase equals a 2.85% increase in the COA water line Contract.

#### Hello Eddie,

Hope your day is going well. Below is City written response to RFIs #11, 12, & 13 as discussed at the meeting on August 8, 2020. Please let me know if you need any additional information or clarification. My apologies for the tardy response. Also, please include Eva Moore on all correspondences relating to this project. Thank you.

**RFI #11:** DeNucci requests separate pay item for potholing for proposed additional work. We have already had multiple instances that we are requesting reimbursement. For example, on the new construction plans at the Tee of Broadmeade and Braes Valley on sheet C-105, additional potholing is required to find couplings for A.C pipe, so we know how much D.I pipe to lay and how much A.C. pipe to remove without compromising the rest of the existing A.C. pipe which will stay.

<u>CoA Response</u>: **1**. Per design plans, potholing to identify pipe alignment and depth is subsidiary to the pipe installation and will not be paid for.

- **2**. Any potholing outside of this already done by the Contractor will be evaluated by City personnel Rick Glosson and Rick Ramones, and determine eligibility for payment.
- 3. Any future pot for reimbursement must first be approved by City Personnel.

**RFI #12**: Standard Practice is the utility locate should be within 18"+/- of actual locate position. In instances where locate is more than 18" off from actual line location, DeNucci requests reimbursement for additional potholing, and pavement repair. Attached is a picture where the AWU locate painted lines show the existing water line going, consequently our crew began to lay the new service line approx. 4' away from existing markings and they ended up hitting the existing service. This caused a loss in production and increased the overall cost due to added repairs.

<u>CoA Response</u>: The typical range of Utility Locate Line is 2-2.5' on either side of the line. The City personnel will evaluate existing lines outside of this range and the City shall compensate Contractor accordingly.

**RFI #13**: Water line plans do not call out mailbox removals and replacements (for example Sheet C-105). The storm sewer plans call out mailbox removal and replacement, where storm sewer work is taking place. On the water line plans, where COA water line work extends past or is located outside of storm sewer work, as on Braes Valley, the plans do not address the mailbox locations which are consistently directly above the existing COA water line that shows to be removed.

CoA Response: Whenever possible, the City will redesign and eliminate any impact to brick mailbox. Any regular mailbox already impacted and relocated will be paid for per bid price. Future potential impact to any mailbox should be brought to City personnel attention and decision made prior to removal and relocation of mailbox.
