1A: Design Error or Omission. Incorrect PS&E. This Change Order adds two new items for wood fence gates that were not included in the original plans. Wood fence is shown to be removed and replaced but no items were established to replace wood fence gates encountered within the fence removal areas. **2E: Differing Site Conditions (unforeseeable). Miscellaneous difference in site conditions (unforeseeable).** This Change Order also adds an item to compensate the Contractor for the cost to relocate a copper water service line on the private side of the water line service at 13013 Stillforest Street. The existing copper water service line is required to be moved because it is in conflict with proposed storm sewer installation. The County is paying the cost of this Change Order.

Change Order No. 5

Reason for Change

This Change Order adds two new items to pay the Contractor for wood fence gates. The plans call for removal of existing wood fence and installation of new wood fence but there are not any pay items set up in the Contract for new wood fence gates. Items 701S-F (Pedestrian Gate) and 701S-G (Vehicular Gate) are added to pay for gate installation.

This Change Order adds an item to cover the cost to relocate a copper water line on the private side of the water line service at 13013 Stillforest Street. This water line service is required to be moved due to a conflict with the installation of a storm sewer structure in Channel NC2-1. The original line was a copper line and the homeowner requested the relocated line to be the same material. The new pay item compensates the Contractor for the difference in price between the installation of a copper line and a PVC line.

This Change Order also corrects a unit price error in the Contract for Item 999-WC02. This adds only 2 dollars to the Contract. The County is paying the cost of this Change Order.

The following new items will be added by this Change Order.

This Change Order results in a net increase of \$5,117.00 to the Contract amount, for an adjusted Contract total of \$4,855,602.52. The original Contract amount was \$4,793,058.15. As a result of this and all Change Orders to-date, \$62,544.37 has been added to the Contract, resulting in a 1.30% net increase in the overall Contract cost. No time will be added to the Contract for this Change Order.

> Had a chance to look back in the Phase I plans and unfortunately I don't think this item fits the fence work for the Phase III project. The item in Phase I was for a large specialty steel gate down in a creek and the gates needed for Phase III are for pedestrian and possible vehicular wood fence gates. If pricing quote is a little closer to the \$350 to \$400 range for the pedestrian gates and \$600-700 range for the vehicular gates then I think we can probably get by without a complete breakdown of the pricing.
