And at said meeting, among other business, the Court considered the following:


**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Williamson County that the Assistant District Attorney SVU Prosecutor Project be operated for the 2021/2022 FY; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the Project as required by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women grant application; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, Williamson County assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court designates the County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Commissioners Court approves submission of the grant application for the Assistant District Attorney SVU Prosecutor Project to the Office of the Governor.
