WHEREAS, The Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Williamson County that the Williamson County Felony Mental Health Court be operated for the 2021/2022 year; and

WHEREAS, there is not a required match for the funding announcement: Specialty Courts Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, Commissioners Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, Williamson County assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

WHEREAS, the Williamson County Commissioners Court designates Judge Bill Gravell Jr. as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners Court approves submission of the grant application for the Williamson County Felony Mental Health Court to the Office of the Governor.
