Exhibit "A" Allowable Expenses: This amendment will change the allowable expenses set forth on Exhibit "A" to add and cover the reasonable costs of temporary staff to process the applications and the pro rata share of the Agency's single audit cost associated with managing these funds. The not-to-exceed amount for these additional costs are eight-nine thousand six-hundred-ninety dollars (\$89,690.00)¹ for administrative-related expenses and an additional fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) for a single audit for a *total additional funding* of one-hundred-four thousand six-hundred-ninety dollars (\$104,690.00). Combined with the original funding, the grand total and not-to-exceed amount under this Agreement shall be one-hundred-ninety-four thousand three-hundred-eighty dollars (\$194,380.00).
