And at said meeting, among other business, the Court considered the following

RESOLUTION: National Stop the Bleed Day May 20, 2021

WHEREAS, trauma is the leading cause of death in citizens aged 1 to 44 and the third leading cause in ages 45-64. Bleeding is the number one cause of preventable death after trauma and victims may die prior to the arrival of first responders; and

WHEREAS, the public should learn how to recognize life-threatening hemorrhage and proper techniques for bleeding control. This education can build confidence and confidence leads to a willingness to act; and

WHEREAS, Stop the Bleed is a national initiative to educate the public in bleeding control techniques and was launched in 2015. Furthermore, in 2019, the Texas Legislature passed H.B. 496 requiring bleeding control education in all public and open-enrollment charter schools; and

WHEREAS, Williamson County EMS has been at the forefront of this movement. Our Williamson County EMS Hemorrhage Control program is one of four approved by the Texas Education Agency for presentation in Texas schools. Williamson County EMS in conjunction with our regional partners have provided training to over 5,400 citizens and as of May 20th our education will be available nation-wide; and

WHEREAS, we encourage citizens to seek education and training related to bleeding control so they can act in emergency situations, this can be the difference between life and death.

Therefore be it resolved, the Williamson County Commissioners Court recognizes National Stop the Bleed Day on May 20, 2021.
