# Historical Background

- 45 Eligible Participants from 9/19 to 3/20
- Only accepting 1 per wk due to only 1 Case Mgr
- 8 month Hiatus from March 2020-Nov 2020

# Participants

- 29 Participants Allowed to Receive Services

- 12 ACTIVE

- 12 GRADUATED = 70.5% Success Rate

5 were not successful in the program

- \* 8 others were randomized out

# Major Events

Covid Impact – (13 months)- A LOT FEWER ARRESTS

LSJA Contract Issues- Getting out of contract, look for Director

Terence Davis – Hired Oct 1, 2020

Mr. Davis applies for 501c(3) Non-Profit Entity

Nov/Dec 2020- Get New Database up and running

Jan 2021- Interview and Hire 2 New Case Managers

Jan 2021- House Project- raise 5K and over 25 volunteers

Feb 2021- Diaper Drive for Participant

Mar 2021- Counseling Crisis – loss of counselor with BBT

Mar 2021- Director pays for counselor personally

April 2021- Secure 6 volunteer counselors for program

# Major Events

April 2021- Updated website for DL/ID Cards/Insurance

April 2021- 501c(3) Was Approved by IRS (April 17, 2021)

May 2021- Begin capturing participant testimonials

# Interesting Facts

93% of our participants are indigent.

Indigent = more time in jail

65% are racial minorities and 24% are females

75% received individual counseling

Most have high ACE scores (Adverse Childhood Experiences)



# Interesting Facts

5 participants obtained their GED in program (17.5%)

1 got H.S. Diploma while in program

2 Obtained Health Insurance Coverage

4 Volunteer for other non-profit programs

# Interesting Facts

2 desired Parenting Classes

1 had a baby during the program

2 required Psychiatric Services

4 were directly connected with employment

We helped two get their Driver's License

We have software database capable of management

Arrests are picking up again

Our system can easily handle 100 participants in 12 months
