## IN THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF WILLIAMSON COUNTY, TEXAS

## **RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Williamson County, Texas, has found and determined that in order to promote the public safety, to facilitate the safety and movement of traffic, and to preserve the financial investment of the public in its roadways, public necessity requires acquisition of fee simple title to that certain tract of land being 1.329 acres (Parcel 3) described by metes and bounds in Exhibit "A" owned by CHRISTINA A. HELMS-EXECUTOR OF THE ESTATE OF JAMES W. FORBES, Deceased for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, maintaining, and operating the Liberty Hill Bypass roadway improvements ("Project"), excluding all the oil, gas, and sulphur which can be removed from beneath said real property, without any right whatever remaining to the owner of such oil, gas, and sulphur of ingress to or egress from the surface of said real property for the purpose of exploring, developing, or mining of the same, as a part of the improvements to the Project, at such locations as are necessary and that such constructing, reconstructing, maintaining, and operating shall extend across and upon, and will cross, run through, and be upon the hereinafter described real properties; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Williamson County, Texas, has, through agents employed by the said office, entered into bona fide good faith negotiations with the owners of the hereinafter described properties and has failed to agree with the owners on the compensation and damages, if any, due to said owners. Now, therefore, the Commissioners' Court of Williamson County, Texas is authorizing the use of its power of eminent domain to condemn property.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF THE COUNTY

OF WILLIAMSON, that the County Attorney or his designated agent be and he is hereby

authorized and directed to file or cause to be filed against the owners of any interest in,

and the holders of any lien secured by, the following described tracts of land, described in

Exhibit "A" attached hereto, a suit in eminent domain to acquire the property interests for

the aforesaid purposes; and

It is the intent of the Commissioners' Court that this resolution authorizes the

condemnation of all property interests required to complete the construction and

maintenance of the Project and associated public purposes. If it is later determined that

there are any errors in the descriptions contained herein or if later surveys contain more

accurate revised descriptions, the County Attorney is authorized to have such errors

corrected or revisions made without the necessity of obtaining a new resolution of the

Commissioners' Court authorizing the condemnation of the corrected or revised Property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Attorney or his designated agent

be and he is hereby authorized and directed to incur such expenses and to employ such

experts as he shall deem necessary to assist in the prosecution of such suit in eminent

domain, including, but not limited to, appraisers, engineers, and land use planners or

other required expert consultants.

BEGINNING at an iron rod with an aluminum cap stamped "WILLIAMSON COUNTY" found in the proposed westerly Right-of-Way (ROW) line of Bagdad Road (ROW width varies) 108.80 feet left of Bagdad Road Baseline Station 312+35.08 (Grid Coordinates determined as N=10,209,547.95 E=3,057,509.65), being in the northerly boundary line of said 10.005 acre tract, same being in the southerly boundary line of that called 23.017 acre tract of land described in Gift Deed to Scott Lee Ira Helms recorded in Document No. 2014043759 of the Official Public Records of Williamson County, Texas, for the northwesterly corner and POINT OF BEGINNING of the herein described parcel, and from which, an iron rod with an aluminum cap stamped "WILLIAMSON COUNTY" found, being an ell corner in said proposed westerly ROW line of said Bagdad Road bears N 20°48'06" W, at a distance of 11.68 feet, and also from which, an iron rod with a plastic cap stamped "FOREST SURVEYING RPLS 1847" found, in the southerly line of said 23.017 acre tract, being the northwesterly corner of said 10.005 acre tract bears S 67°41'38" W, at a distance of 1,033,22 feet;

- THENCE, departing said proposed westerly ROW line, with the northerly boundary line of said 10.005 acre tract, same being the southerly boundary line of said 23.017 acre tract, N 67°41'38" E, for a distance of 141.73 feet to a 1/2" iron rod found in the existing westerly ROW line of said County Road 279 (Bagdad Road) (variable width ROW), being the southeasterly corner of said 23.017 acre tract, same being the northeasterly corner of said 10.005 acre tract and of the herein described parcel;
- 2) THENCE, with said existing westerly ROW line, being the easterly boundary line of said 10.005 acre tract, S 19°09'29" E, for a distance of 427.65 feet to an iron rod with a plastic cap stamped "FOREST SURVEYING RPLS 1847" found, being the southeasterly corner of said 10.005 acre tract, same being the northeasterly corner of that called 13.205 acre tract of land described in Deed Without Warranty to Scott L. I. Helms recorded in Document No. 2020012722 of the Official Public Records of Williamson County, Texas, for the southeasterly corner of the herein described parcel;
- 3) THENCE, departing said existing westerly ROW line, with the southerly boundary line of said 10.005 acre tract, same being the northerly boundary line of said 13.205 acre tract, S 67°41'35" W, for a distance of 129.46 feet to an iron rod with an aluminum cap stamped "WILLIAMSON COUNTY" set in said proposed westerly ROW line 109.31 feet left of Bagdad Road Baseline Station 308+17.84, for the southwesterly corner of the herein described parcel;
- 4) THENCE, departing said 13.205 acre tract, with said proposed westerly ROW line, through the interior of said 10.005 acre tract, N 20°48'06" W, for a distance of 427.15 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING, containing 1.329 acres (57,900 square feet) of land, more or less.
