Once the form is received by the Williamson County Purchasing Department, the contact associated with the project will log-in to the Texas Ethics Commission portal and acknowledge receipt of the form. The completed form will be made available via the Texas Ethics Commission website. Accordingly, a new filing must be completed for each awarded contract (new, amended, extended, or renewed) requiring Commissioners' Court approval.

House Bill 1295, adopted by the 84th Legislature, created §2252.908, Texas Government Code. Section 2252.908 requires a business entity entering certain contracts with a governmental entity or state agency to file with the governmental entity or state agency a disclosure of interested parties at the time the business entity submits the signed contract to the governmental entity or state agency. The code requires the commission to adopt rules necessary to implement the new disclosure requirement and to prescribe the disclosure form. Section 2252.908 requires the disclosure form to be signed by the authorized agent of the contracting business entity, acknowledging that the disclosure is made under oath and under penalty of perjury. Section 2252.908 applies only to a contract that requires an action or vote by the governing body of the governmental or state agency before the contract may be signed or has a value of at least \$1 million. Section 2252.908 provides definitions of certain terms occurring in this section and applies only to contracts entered on or after January 1, 2016.

An interested party is defined as a person who has a controlling interest in a business entity with whom a governmental entity or state agency contracts or who actively participates in facilitating the contract or negotiating the terms of the contract, including a broker, intermediary, adviser, or attorney for the business entity.
