constituting a quorum, when among other business, the following was transacted under Item No. 28 of said meeting:


Consideration and action on authorizing a percentage-based exemption from ad valorem taxes on the appraised value of the residence homestead in the amount of 5.0 percent of the appraised value of the individual's residence homestead or a minimum of \$5,000, as authorized by Section 11.13(n) of the Property Tax Code and to be effective for the tax year beginning on January 1, 2022.
