

AGREEMENT TO TERMINATE AGREEMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES

This Agreement To Terminate that certain Agreement for Construction Services ("Termination") is made and entered into effective as of the latest date of the signatories indicated at the conclusion of this document, by and between Williamson County, Texas a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas ("County") and Contractor.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, County and Contractor are parties to that certain Agreement for Construction Services dated effective July 13, 2022, being awarded to Contractor under Williamson County Invitation for Bid (IFB) Solicitation #22IFB113 ("Agreement"), wherein Contractor agreed to provide milling and inlay construction services in connection with the Project;

WHEREAS, County and Contractor desire to terminate the Agreement as of the Effective Date of Termination set out herein below.

NOW, THEREFORE, County and Contractor, for and in consideration of the premises contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby forever acknowledged and confessed, do mutually agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1 TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT

1.1 Termination.

On the terms set forth herein, County and Contractor mutually agree to terminate the Agreement.

1.2 Effective Date of Termination.

The Effective Date of Termination of the Agreement shall be December 6, 2022.

1.3 Completed and Uncompleted Work.

- 1.3.1 As of the Effective Date of Termination, as set out herein below, County and Contractor agree that Contractor has fully completed the Work set forth in Exhibit "A" with such completion having occurred as of the dates denoted in said Exhibit "A" ("Completed Work").
- **1.3.2** As of the Effective Date of Termination, as set out herein below, County and Contractor agree that Contractor has not commenced or completed the Work set forth in Exhibit "B" ("Uncompleted Work").

1.4 Full Payment; Waiver and Release by Contractor; Warranty of Payment

Contactor hereby agrees that it has been paid by County in full for all labor, services, equipment, or materials furnished on the Project prior to the Effective Date of Termination. For and in consideration of such full payment made by County, the sufficiency of which is acknowledged by Contractor, Contractor, for and on behalf of itself and all persons claiming by, through or under it, hereby releases and forever discharges the County, its Commissioners Court, and all of their officers, directors, employees, attorneys, agents and servants and their respective predecessors, successors and assigns, of and from, any and all claim, loss, liability, damage, cost or expense that arises out of or relates to the Agreement or the Project, from the commencement of the Work through the Effective Date of Termination and whether for contract balances, extra or additional work, change orders, delays, acceleration, disruption, lost productivity or inefficiency, cost escalation, extended home or field office overhead or expense, interest, penalties for late payment, attorneys' fees, or any other financial or economic loss or damage of any kind or nature, and whether arising in tort (including negligence and negligent misrepresentation), in contract or otherwise. Contractor further warrants that it has already paid in full all of the Contractor's laborers, subcontractors, materialmen, and suppliers for all work, materials, equipment, or services provided for or to the Project as of the Effective Date of Termination.

1.5 No Waiver by County

Contractor acknowledges and agrees that County is not releasing Contractor from any liability as to the Completed Work that was performed prior to the Effective Date of Termination and that County's agreement to the terminate the Agreement shall not serve as a waiver of claims arising out of any failure of Contractor's Completed Work to comply with the terms of the Agreement, which may be unknown to the County as of the Effective Date of Termination, nor is County waiving any of the terms and conditions of any warranties required under the Agreement as to the Completed Work.

1.6 Obligations Under Agreement Following Termination.

Contractor shall have no obligation to perform any of the Uncompleted Work and County hereby releases Contractor from any obligations to perform such Uncompleted Work following the Effective Date of Termination. County and Contractor shall have no continued obligations under the Agreement after the Effective Date of Termination, with the exception of any obligations accruing prior to the Effective Date of Termination and any obligations that extend beyond the

Effective Date of Termination under the terms of the Agreement, which shall include, but not be limited to commissioning and warranty responsibilities in relation to the Completed Work or indemnification obligations, insurance obligations and bond obligations in relation to the Completed Work.

ARTICLE 2 GENERAL PROVISIONS

2.1 Entire Agreement.

County and Contractor acknowledge that this Termination embodies the entire agreement and understanding between them with respect to the Project and supersedes any prior Agreements or Amendments relating to the Project. This Termination may not be altered, modified, or discharged except by a writing signed by the party against whom such alteration, modification, or discharge is sought.

2.2 Identical Counterparts.

This Termination may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall, for all purposes, be deemed to be an original and all of which shall collectively constitute the same instrument, but in making proof of this Termination, only one such counterpart need be produced or accounted for.

2.3 Representation and Construction.

By executing this Termination, County and Contractor acknowledge that they have had the opportunity to be represented by independent counsel and review and consider the terms of the Termination. This Termination shall not be construed against or in favor of any party due to the fact that such party may or may not have authored said Termination or any provision contained herein.

ARTICLE 3 SIGNATORY WARRANTY

The undersigned signatory for Contractor hereby represents and warrants that the signatory is an officer of the organization for which he/she has executed this Termination and that he/she has full and complete authority to enter into this Termination on behalf of the firm.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, County has caused this Termination to be signed in its name by its duly authorized Presiding Officer, thereby binding the parties hereto, their successors, assigns and representatives for the faithful and full performance of the terms and provisions hereof. NO OFFICIAL, EMPLOYEE, AGENT, OR REPRESENTATIVE OF THE COUNTY HAS ANY AUTHORITY, EITHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, TO AMEND OR MODIFY THIS TERMINATION, EXCEPT PURSUANT TO SUCH EXPRESS AUTHORITY AS MAY BE GRANTED BY THE WILLIAMSON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT.






