A RESOLUTION OF WILLIAMSON COUNTY ADOPTING THE WILLIAMSON COUNTY 2025 HAZARD MITIGATION ACTION PLAN.

WHEREAS, Williamson County recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within Williamson County; and

WHEREAS, the County of Williamson has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as Williamson County 2025 Hazard Mitigation Action Plan in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, Williamson County 2025 Hazard Mitigation Plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Williamson County from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, adoption by the County Commissioners Court demonstrates their commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Williamson County 2025 Mitigation Action Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WILLIAMSON COUNTY, TEXAS, THAT:

The County Commissioner's Court adopts the Williamson County 2025 Hazard Mitigation Action Plan. This plan, approved by the community, may be edited or amended after submission for review, but will not require the community to re-adopt any further iterations. This only applies to this specific plan and does not absolve the community from updating the plan in 5 years.
