Reason for Change

This Change Order compensates the Contractor for constructing the UPRR shoo-fly and box culverts at US 79, per the required plan revisions. The final 100% plan set, issued after bid opening, includes the revised culvert and shoo-fly work. Quantity adjustments and new items were required, per the plan revisions.
