**WHEREAS**, Dr. Sandrock is well-known and will always be remembered for his rock-star talent, infectious good humor, and disheveled hair-do; and


**WHEREAS**, Dr. Sandrock will always be respected and admired for his hands-on approach to solving problems and his shoulder to shoulder work ethic.
