AN ORDINANCE OF THE YOLO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
CONSOLIDATING THE OFFICES OF THE YOLO COUNTY SHERIFF-CORONER AND
PUBLIC ADMINISTRATOR AND ADOPTING ADDITIONS TO THE COUNTY CODE OF
ORDINANCES NECESSARY AND RESULTING FROM THE CONSOLIDATION OF
THESE OFFICES

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo ordains as follows:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The Board of Supervisors has determined that consolidating the office of the Sheriff-Coroner with the office of the Public Administrator will promote efficient and effective government and is therefore in the public interest.

SECTION II. ADDITION TO THE YOLO COUNTY CODE

Chapter 5 of Title 2 of the Yolo County Code is revised to add Section 2-5.117, to read as follows:

Section 2-5.117. Consolidation of Offices: Sheriff-Coroner and Public Administrator

- (a) The County elective offices of Sheriff and Coroner and Public Administrator are consolidated into a single office. Such office shall be known as Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator.
- (b) The person filling the consolidated office shall be the current Sheriff-Coroner and shall be known as the Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator. Any reference in this Code to Sheriff or Coroner or Public Administrator shall mean Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator.

SECTION III. SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the remaining sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases of this ordinance, or their application to any other person or circumstance.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect 30 days after its passage. The Clerk of the Board shall cause this ordinance or a summary thereof to be published as required by law.

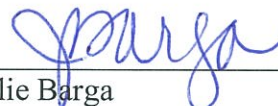
