(Resolution Increasing the Public Defender's Budget in the Amount of \$3,272)

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed its ability to provide general fund allocations to departments in amounts necessary to fund requested safety and security improvements; and

WHEREAS, the set aside a safety and security contingency during the 2016-17 Adopted Budget hearings to assist departments with requests for improvements designed to make the work environment more secure; and

WHEREAS, the Public Defender has requested funds with which to install a security gate designed to limit nighttime visitors to the facility; and

WHEREAS, appropriations included in the Public Defender's fiscal year 2016/17 budget are not available to fund security improvements; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 29125 provides for transfer from appropriation for contingencies by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, RESOLVED THAT:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Public Defender's budget and Contingency budgets for fiscal year 2016/17 are amended as follows:
