**(Resolution Increasing Appropriations in the Sheriff's Budget for
Fiscal Year 2016-2017 in the Amount of \$105,000)**

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Sheriff's Office has received funding through the *Anti-Theft funds* to provide theft deterrent equipment; and

WHEREAS, the one-time transfer of these contingency funds are for the sole purpose of purchasing a replacement License Plate Reader and will not be considered a part of the Sheriff's Office's ongoing operations for budgetary purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office has also received funding through YCPARMIA for the replacement of a vehicle that was damaged; and

WHEREAS, said moneys were not included in appropriations and estimated revenue of the Sheriff's Patrol Budget for Fiscal Year 2016-17; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the California Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Financial Services is authorized to increase the budget for fiscal year 2016-2017 as follows:

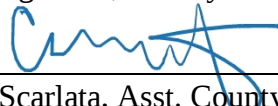
