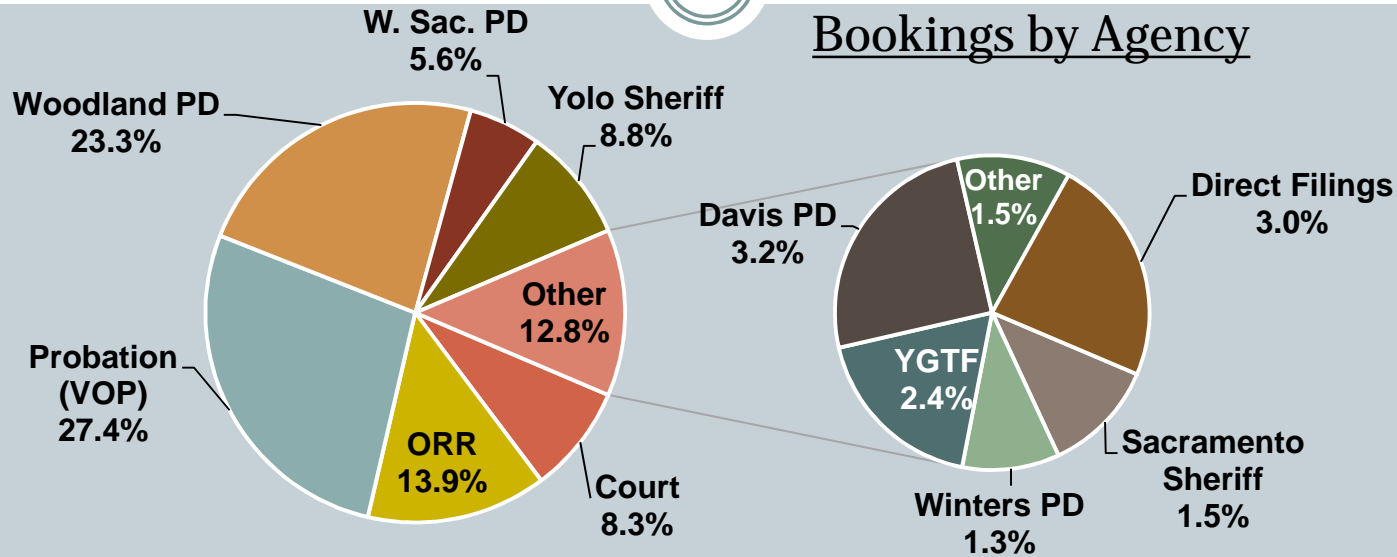

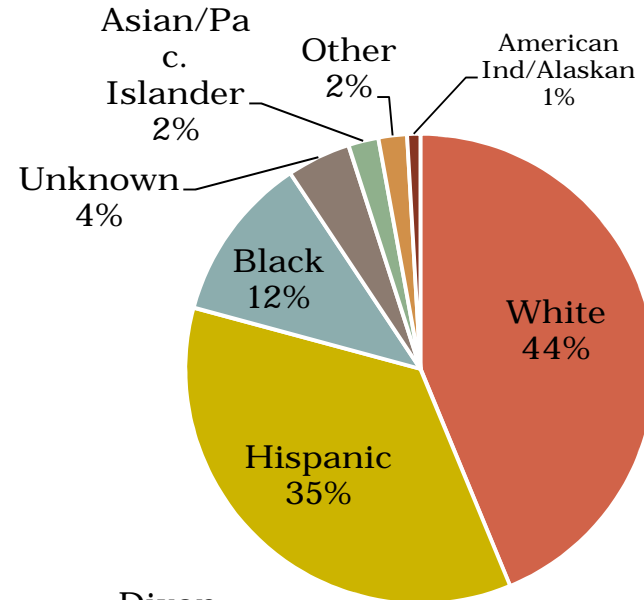

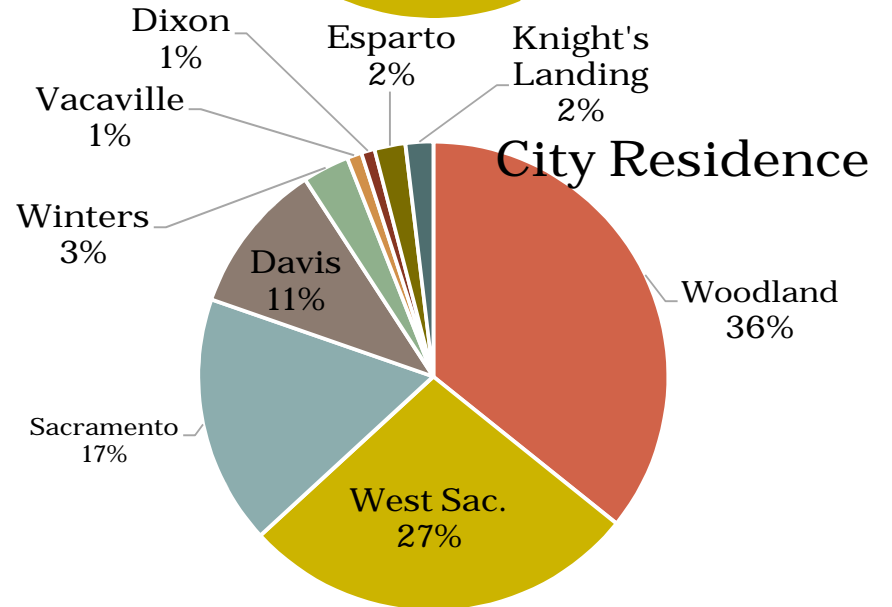
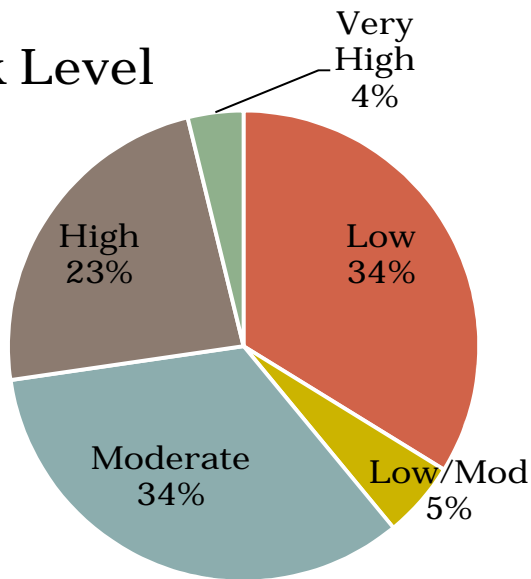
# Supervised Probation Demographics

Race

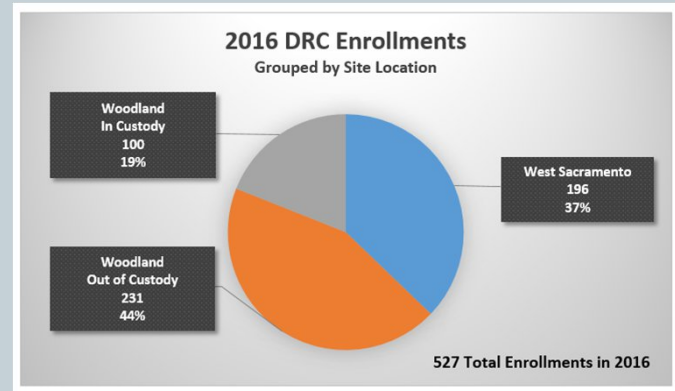
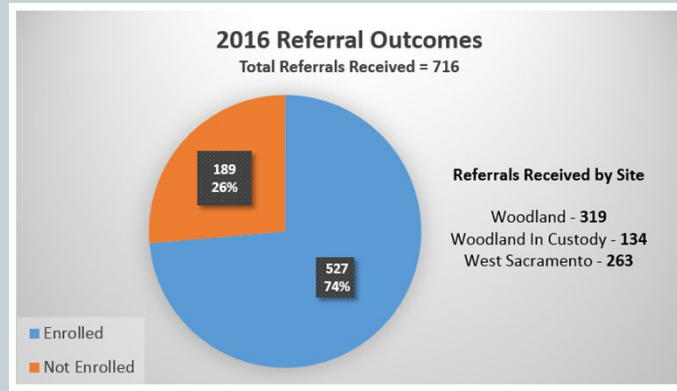
Risk Level



City Residence

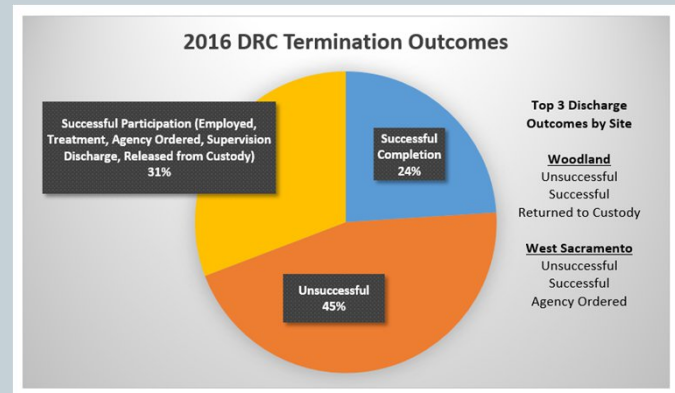
# Day Reporting Center 2016 Program Data

## Noteworthy Outcomes from Program Year 2016

- 74% of Referrals were enrolled into program
- DRC locations enrolled over 500 clients in 2016
- 55% of enrolled clients successfully participated in or completed the DRC program

Only Yolo County Recidivism (excludes crime outside County)

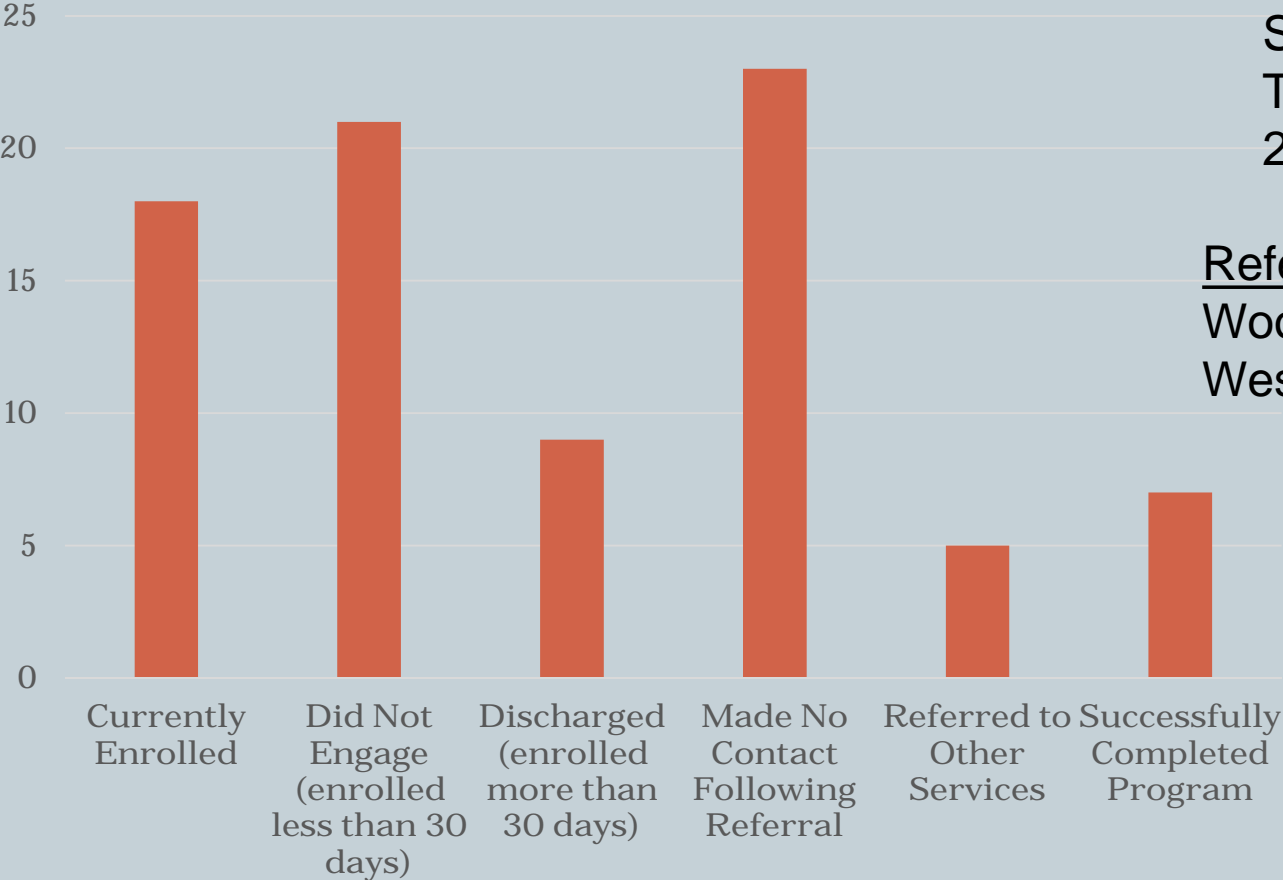

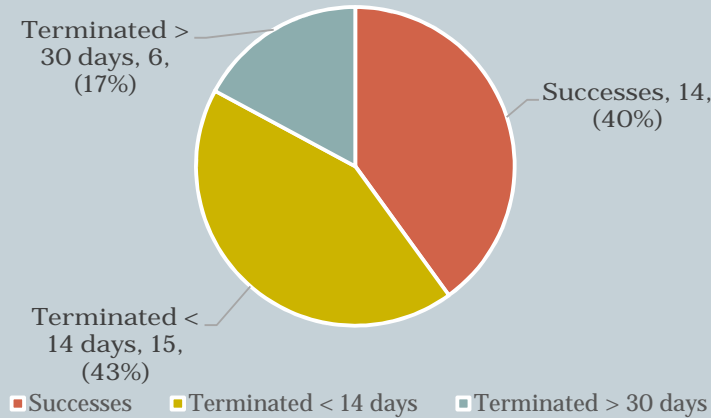

Terminated clients are broken down by those who were terminated prior to reaching 14 days (end of blackout) and those who were terminated after being in the program for 30 days.

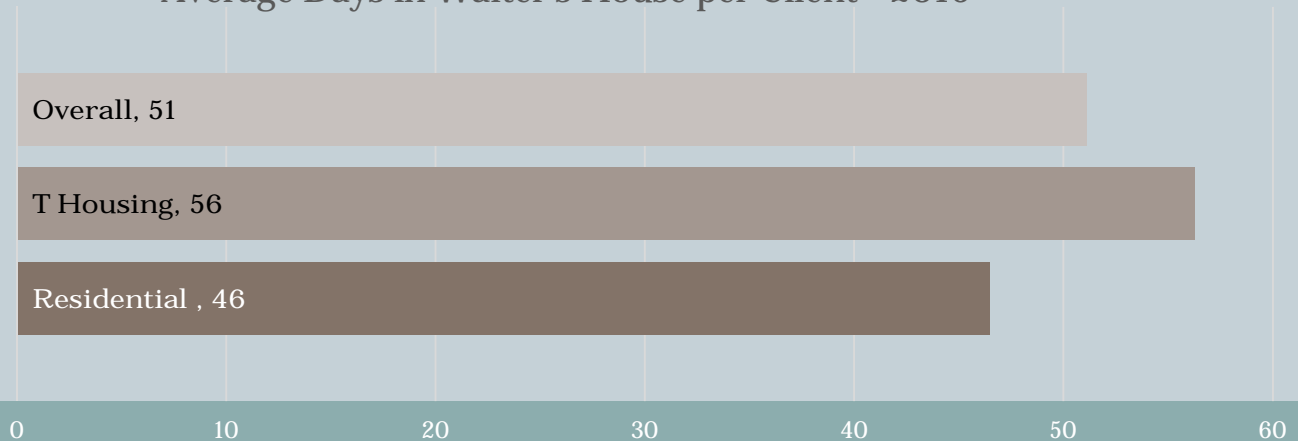
## Average Number of Clients Served - 2016

## Average Days in Walter's House per Client - 2016

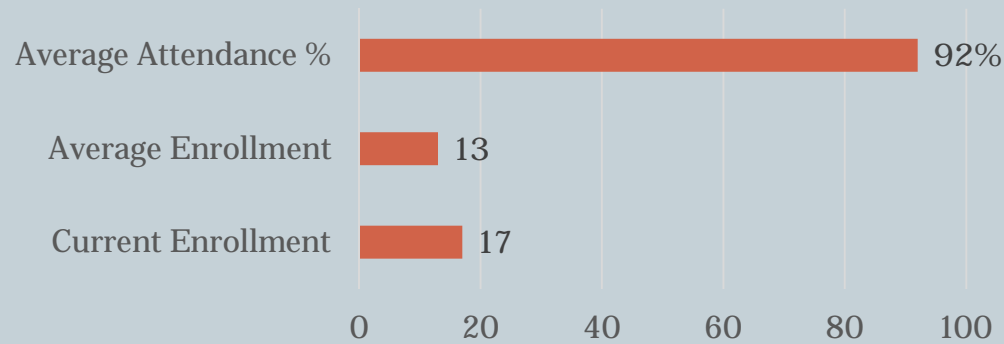
Walter's House had 36 Probation referrals for Residential and Transitional Housing during 2016



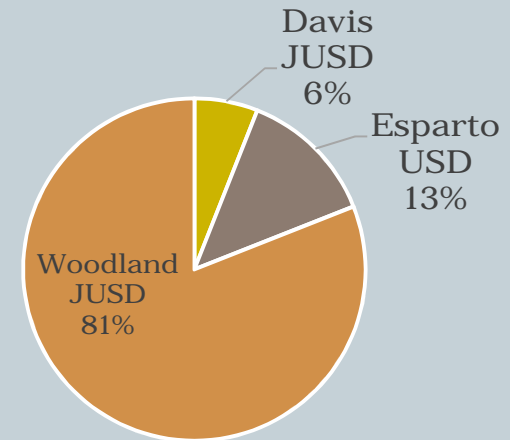
