**(Resolution Increasing Appropriations in the Sheriff's Budget for
Fiscal Year 2017-2018 in the Amount of \$110,000)**

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Sheriff's Office has received funding through the cannabis program that provides for the monitoring and permitting of medicinal cannabis cultivation in the unincorporated are of Yolo County; and

WHEREAS, the one-time transfer of these funds is for the sole purpose of purchasing a surveillance camera system for the Aero Squad plane to assist with the monitoring of the legal grows and will not be considered a part of the department's ongoing operations for budgetary purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Sheriff's Office will be reimbursed from the cannabis fund for the purchase of the surveillance camera system; and

WHEREAS, these funds were not included in appropriations and estimated revenue of the Sheriff's Patrol Budget for Fiscal Year 2017-18; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the California Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to amend the budget for fiscal year 2017-2018 as follows:

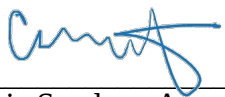
