**(Resolution Increasing Appropriations in the Sheriff's Budget for
Fiscal Year 2017-2018 in the Amount of \$55,110)**

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Sheriff's Office has received a \$50,100 grant through the California Department of Parks and Recreation Division of Boating and Waterways to remove navigational impediments and safety hazards from Yolo County waterways as part of boat patrol operations; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires a 10% local agency match of funds which will come from the West Sacramento Regional Sanitation funds; and

WHEREAS, said moneys were not included in appropriations and estimated revenue of the Sheriff's Boat Patrol Budget for Fiscal Year 2017-18; and

WHEREAS, there would be no net fiscal impact to the County General fund for fiscal year 2017-18 by making these adjustments; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the California Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Auditor-Controller is authorized to increase the budget for fiscal year 2017-18 as follows:

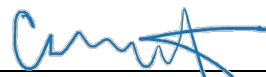
