Resolution of the Yolo County Board of Supervisors Adopting A Minor Revision to the Adopted Williamson Act Guidelines

WHEREAS, on_____, 2018, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors held a public hearing and considered the above-referenced project (Zone File #2016-0043);

WHEREAS, the State Williamson Act statutes require that “the board or council, by resolution, shall adopt rules governing the administration of agricultural preserves...” (Government Code Section 51231); and

WHEREAS, these rules must include “procedures for initiating, filing, and processing requests to establish agricultural preserves” and may enumerate compatible uses on contracted lands; and

WHEREAS, one minor provision of the proposed Guidelines was inadvertently left out of the final version that was adopted by the Board of Supervisors on December 12, 2017, even though the staff report specifically referred to the provision. The clause that is to be inserted into the adopted Guidelines addresses conveyance or sale of contracted parcels; and

WHEREAS, an Environmental Determination has been prepared in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors hereby finds and resolves as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. For the foregoing reasons, and for all reasons described in all other documents in the record for this matter, the Board thus adopts the revision to the adopted Williamson Act Guidelines.
3. A Notice of Determination shall be filed promptly after approval of the project. The Director of the Community Services Department, located at 292 West Beamer Street in Woodland, California, shall serve as the custodian of the administrative record.

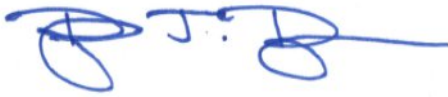
