A Resolution Increasing Fiscal Year 2017-2018 County Administrator Budget by \$490,000
for MBK Engineers contract payments

WHEREAS, in May 2017, the County was awarded \$1,500,000 in Small Communities Flood Risk Reduction grants from the State Department of Water Resources (DWR). The grants will support flood risk reduction studies for the communities of Clarksburg, Knights Landing, and Yolo; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into a contract with MBK Engineers in the amount of \$1,470,000 for the purpose of conducting the flood risk reduction feasibility studies funded by the State Department of Water Resources grant; and

WHEREAS, the County Administrator's Office budget for fiscal year 2017-2018 does not include in the estimated appropriations the 2017-2018 expenses of \$490,000 for the MBK Engineers contract and the grant funding for it; and

WHEREAS, Section 29125 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized and directed to amend the budget for fiscal year 2017/18 as follows:
