**Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo
Adopting the Yolo County's SB-1 Local Streets and Roads Funding List for Fiscal Year
2018/19**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of Yolo County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the California Streets and Highways code provides that Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) funds shall be prioritized for expenditure on basic road maintenance and road rehabilitation projects, and on critical safety projects; and

WHEREAS, in order to receive RMRA funds, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors must adopt a list of proposed projects by resolution at a regularly scheduled public meeting; and

WHEREAS, adopting the project list does not limit the flexibility of the County to fund projects in accordance with local needs and priorities, so long as the projects are consistent with RMRA priorities of basic road maintenance and road rehabilitation, and critical safety projects, as outlined in the State Streets and Highways Code Section 2030(b); and

WHEREAS, because the actual revenue generated by SB1 will vary depending on fuel sales, and because actual construction costs will vary from estimated costs due to the construction bidding market at the time of construction, it is anticipated that the County's adopted project list will need to be modified as project plans and specifications are developed to accommodate variations in revenues and costs; and

WHEREAS, the proposed list must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo as follows:

1. The Board hereby adopts the list of projects attached hereto as Exhibit A that are planned to be funded with RMRA revenues.

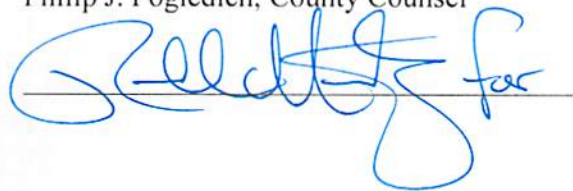
