

RESOLUTION NO. 17-_____

(Resolution increasing the District Attorney's Office budget, \$59,000 for purchase of two license plate reader camera systems using Public Safety Contingency funds)

WHEREAS, the Yolo County District Attorney's Office is dedicated to pursuing truth and justice for victims and communities with commitment, courage and integrity and has an identified goal of promoting collaboration with their law enforcement partners; and

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Sheriff's Department already owns three license plate reading pods, which will be used in conjunction with the two requested pods, with the goal of creating a "net" around the South-East portion of Yolo County, including Clarksburg; and

WHEREAS, this system, will provide invaluable support to both organizations, being utilized for cases including, but not limited to: human trafficking, arson, homicide, and sex offender prosecution; and

WHEREAS, the largest benefits of license plate readers are in the event of kidnappings and Amber Alerts. When identified vehicles in these cases pass by license plate readers, law enforcement is notified immediately, providing real-time information to authorities; and

WHEREAS, purchase of these two license plate reading pods will create a Yolo County first- an entire community will have a technology "net" assisting public safety, a force multiplier, creating efficiencies for all Yolo County Public Safety agencies; and

WHEREAS, Public Safety Contingency funds are available and have been authorized for this expenditure; and

WHEREAS, said funds were not included in the estimated revenue and appropriations of the District Attorney's Office budget for fiscal year 2017-18; and

WHEREAS, Section 29125 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized and directed to amend the budget for fiscal year 2017-18 as follows:
