As the Confidential Secretary, Ana was responsible for scheduling meetings, tracking Jesse's calendar and appointments, updating management agendas and minutes, keeping statewide legislative meeting agendas and minutes and serving as backup HR generalist and payroll for ACE; and

**WHEREAS**, Ana was reclassified as an Executive Assistant to better align with her gifted talents and knowledge; and

**WHEREAS**, Ana has provided invaluable assistance and support to the Clerk-Recorder branch, including serving as a Civil Marriage Commissioner; and

**WHEREAS**, Ana has served and held positions for election related functions such as a poll worker, ballot tabulator, voter assistance center lead and many others. Her support to the democratic process was appreciated and will be sorely missed; and

**WHEREAS**, Ana assisted the fiscal team in many ways and contributed towards the Human Resources responsibilities of our office; and

**WHEREAS**, Ana epitomizes poise and professionalism, and exemplifies outstanding teamwork. She has always made herself available to help with outreach events, on Election Days and on several other occasions when an extra hand is needed; and
