

SECOND AMENDMENT
(BOS No. _____)

This Second Amendment to Agreement No. 17-266 (“Second Amendment”) is made and entered into as of the last date signed below herein by and between the County of Yolo, a political subdivision of the State of California (“County”), and Rural Innovations in Social Economics, Inc. (RISE), a non-profit corporation authorized to do business in the State of California (“Contractor”), jointly referred to as the “Parties” herein and who agree as stated below.

WHEREAS, on or about October 24, 2017, the Parties entered into Agreement No. 17-266 (Agreement); and

WHEREAS, on or about July 21, 2020, the Parties amended the Agreement via the First Amendment; and

WHEREAS, on or about April 12, 2021, the County exercised its option to extend the Agreement under the same terms and conditions via Option Letter #1; and

WHEREAS, the Parties would now like to amend the Agreement, as previously amended to:

1. Revise **Paragraph I.A.** to reflect the current term of the Agreement; and
2. Revise **Paragraph II.C.** to update language; and
3. Revise **Section III.B.** to add funding in the amount of \$1,349.84 for Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-22 for a new contract maximum of \$177,699.68; and
4. Revise **Exhibit E** to update budget for FY 2021-22.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. **Paragraph I.A.** of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

I. TERM

A. The term of this Agreement shall be from **October 1, 2017 through June 30, 2022** unless sooner terminated as provided in this Agreement

2. **Paragraph II.C.** of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

C. Contractor shall also comply with all applicable provisions of the HHS A Mental Health Clinical Documentation Standards Manual 2019 and the HHS A Mental Health Clinical Documentation Companion Guide 2019 (collectively hereinafter referred to as the “Clinical Documentation Guide”), the HHS A Behavioral Health Compliance Plan; and any and all applicable County policies and procedures. The Contractor has accessed and reviewed all of these documents, which are available to the Contractor at website <http://www.yolocounty.org/health-human-services>, and are incorporated herein by this reference. Contractor may also send an email to Health and Human Services Agency (HHS A)-Behavioral Health Quality Management at HHS AQualityManagement@yolocounty.org to obtain copies of any of these documents.

3. **Paragraph III.B.** of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

B. Any other provision of this Agreement notwithstanding, the maximum payment obligation to Contractor through **June 30, 2022** shall be no greater than **ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED NINETY-NINE DOLLARS AND SIXTY-EIGHT CENTS**

(\$177,699.68) specified as follows:

5. Except as specifically amended by this Second Amendment and any prior amendments, the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect according to its terms.
