2. Check-Ins with the Board Ad Hoc Subcommittee and full Board
3. Develop, Revise, Implement, and Evaluate Action Plan

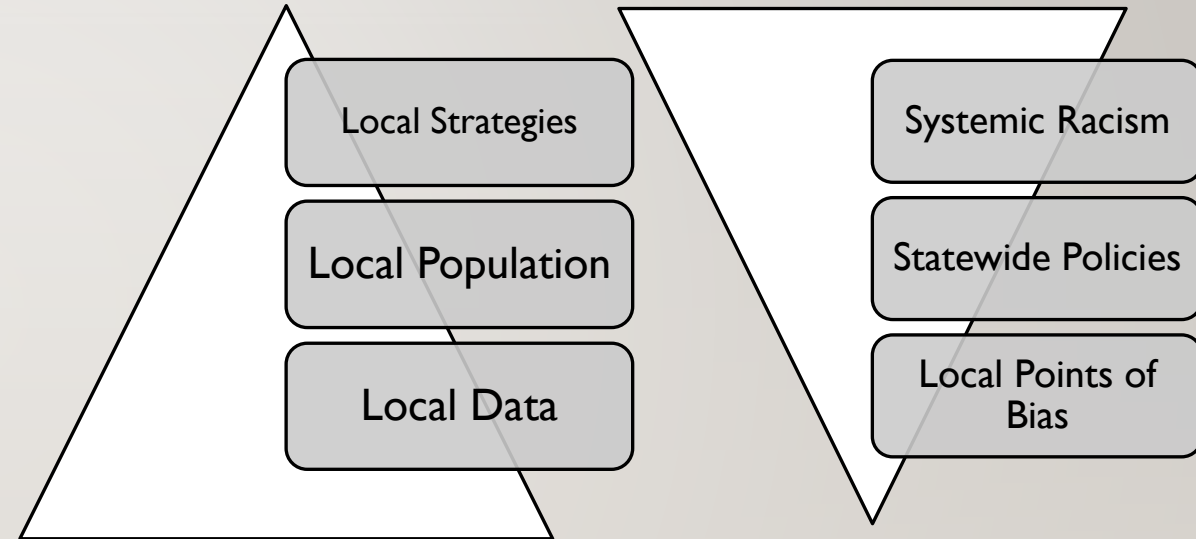
FINDINGS & RECOMMENDATIONS

Findings

- Bottom-Up vs. Top-Down Approach
- Focus on action-oriented planning/implementation

Recommendations

- Gather data focused on where decision-making occurs
- Examine system relationships between populations
- **Develop and implement 1-2 narrowly focused pilots***
- Re-examine existing policy documents for areas of improvement



RECOMMENDATIONS

Develop 1-2 narrowly focused pilots

1. Develop an in-custody population using race and length of stay data to determine targeted treatment
2. Develop domestic violence population using case data, parsing out racial disparities and other determinants of health

Develop 1 process evaluation*

- Identify a process evaluation based on race and Supervised OR to compare total evaluations against placements on Supervised OR for Black individuals countywide

PROCESS EVALUATION/LINK TO PRE-TRIAL TOOL

Supervised OR process evaluation

- Pre-Trial Risk Assessment Tool Validation Report allows for Action Plan implementation
 - Local Data → Local Population → Local Strategies
