Resolution Increasing Appropriations in the Sheriff's Boat Patrol Budget, for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 in the Amount of \$25,000

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Sheriff's Office has received a \$25,000 grant through the California Department of Parks and Recreation Division of Boating and Waterways to remove navigational impediments and safety hazards from Yolo County waterways as part of boat patrol operations; and

WHEREAS, said moneys were not included in appropriations and estimated revenue of the Sheriff's Boat Patrol Budget for Fiscal Year 2021-22; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires a 10%, or \$2,500, local agency match of funds; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office will use existing general fund allocations in their fiscal year 2021-2022 budget to meet the match requirements; and

WHEREAS, Government Code § 29125 provides for the appropriation of funds following budget adoption by a 4/5 vote of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized and directed to amend the budget for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 as follows:
