Hi Angel,

If you recall, we joined a new JPA focused on Broadband called the Golden State Connect Authority (GSCA) in partnership with RCRC back in September. At that time, the board approved the JPA agreement however did not select a delegate to that JPA. They are working to plan their first meeting in November. I spoke with the Chair about the potential for you to be that delegate given that you sit on the RCRC Board and also have many of the underserved broadband communities in your district. The Chair seemed supportive of that logic.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WINTERS
RECOMMENDING TO THE YOLO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS THE
REAPPOINTMENT OF COUNCILMEMBER PIERRE NEU TO THE YOLO COUNTY
HOUSING COMMISSION AND MAYOR WADE COWAN AS AN ALTERNATE**

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Housing Commission is comprised of representatives from each of the incorporated cities in Yolo County, the County of Yolo, and two tenant members; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Pierre Neu has been the Winters' representative since September 2018 and his term expires on October 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Cowan has been the alternate for the Yolo County Housing Commission; and

WHEREAS, both Councilmember Neu and Mayor Cowan would like to be reappointed to the Yolo County Housing Commission, subject to the Board of Supervisors' approval, for another four-year term expiring on October 31, 2025.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Winters does hereby recommend to the Yolo County Board of Supervisors that Councilmember Pierre Neu be reappointed to the Yolo County Housing Commission with Mayor Cowan reappointed as an alternate.
