A Resolution Increasing Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Sheriff’s Office Remote Access Network (RAN)  
Board Budget by \$234,700.

**WHEREAS**, California Penal Code Section 11112.4 establishes a Remote Access Network (RAN) board that will determine placement of RAN equipment to allow local law enforcement direct access to the California Identification System; and

**WHEREAS**, the local RAN board approved the FY2021-22 budget on August 17, 2021 but it was not included in the County’s FY2021-22 Adopted Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, there is no general fund impact since the RAN board is a special revenue fund and has adequate fund balance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sheriff needs approval to increase its FY2021-22 RAN Board budget by \$234,700; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 29125 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized and directed to amend the budget for fiscal year 2021-2022 as follows:
