Resolution to Increase Appropriations in the Sheriff Office’s Detention Budget for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 in the Amount of \$5,000

WHEREAS, the State of California Department of State Hospitals (DSH) has established a program to evaluate felony incompetent to stand trial (IST) individuals in jail who have been waiting for admission to a DSH facility sixty (60) days or more from the date of commitment to reduce the list of defendants waiting for placement for treatment; and

WHEREAS, the DSH will be conducting these evaluations via remote telehealth interviews; and

WHEREAS, the DSH has made available one-time funding in the amount of \$5,000 for participating Sheriff’s Offices to purchase the equipment and software necessary to implement the remote interview process; and

WHEREAS, these funds were not included in appropriations and estimated revenue for the Sheriff’s Detention Budget for Fiscal Year 2021-22; and

WHEREAS, there would be no net fiscal impact to the County General Fund for fiscal year 2021-22 by making these adjustments; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the California Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the 2021-22 fiscal year budget as follows:
