Points to Consider



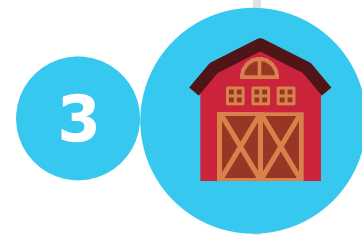
Senior Food Security

Through discussions with stakeholders it is clear there is a lack of coordination amongst senior food security providers. **Senior Food Security Coordination Workgroup** strongly recommended.



Children's Food Security

While Food Security for Children is a key priority all proposals lacked participation and matching funds from key child supports like school districts, Office of Education and Child focused non-profits.



Rural, Unincorporated & AG Worker Food Security

All proposals lacked concrete focus and tangible outcomes for rural communities and ag worker support. Would recommend more discussions on rural programming / food issues in unincorporated.



Innovation and Measureable Outcomes

Though many of the proposals were innovative, many lacked clear outcomes, partnerships and sustainability. Would recommend requesting more detail for several proposals before awarding funds.



Reserving Funding for Future Proposals

There were areas in the Senior, Rural and Childrens food security needs we felt were left unaddressed. We recommend reserving funding for new or refined existing proposals to address unmet need.
