(Resolution Increasing the Fiscal Year 2021-22 Department of Community Services Budget-Public Works/Roads Division Budget by \$99,860)

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Services request to increase the Public Works/Road Division Budget in the amount of \$99,860 for Fiscal Year 2021-22 Quarter 2 (October – December 2021) efforts to assemble construction ready documents, to pursue grant application opportunities, and implement construction of road projects; and

WHEREAS, additional funds are available through use of County Contingency Funds for “Roads” in the approved Fiscal Year 2021-22 County Budget; and

WHEREAS, said funds were not included in the Department of Community Services budget for Fiscal Year 2021-22; and

WHEREAS, Section 29125 of the Government Code provides for the appropriations of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND FOUND as follows:

2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized and directed to amend the budget for Fiscal Year 2021-22 as follows:


