**Resolution authorizing the acceptance of the Public Defense Pilot Program funding from the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) in the amount of \$289,129**

**WHEREAS**, the County of Yolo (the “County”) desires to participate in the Public Defense Pilot Program funded through the State Budget Act of 2021 (Senate Bill 129) and administered by the Board of State and Community Corrections (“BSCC”); and

**WHEREAS**, the BSCC has made available funding for the grant period of March 1, 2022 through March 1, 2025; and.

**WHEREAS**, the BSCC has awarded the County \$289,129.27 to fund the Public Defense Pilot Program for year one;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby resolves as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Board authorizes the Public Defender, on its behalf, to execute the grant award agreement, including any amendments or extensions necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
3. The Board understands and agrees that neither the Board of Supervisors nor the Public Defender may use any grant funds to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
4. The Public Defender and/or Chief Fiscal Admin. Officer, on its behalf, agree to abide by the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the BSCC.
5. The Board understands and agrees that any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant Agreement shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency.
