**(Resolution Increasing the Health and Human Services Agency Budget for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 in the Amount of \$100,000 by Use of Funding from the California Department of Social Services for the Bringing Families Home Program)**

**WHEREAS**, on September 28, 2021, the Board of Supervisors for the County of Yolo adopted a budget for Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-2022 for the Health and Human Services Agency (HHS); and

**WHEREAS**, on February 11, 2022, the California Department of Social Services provided a notice of funding letter to HHS; and

**WHEREAS**, the award letter provided notice that HHS was awarded \$364,365 for the Bringing Families Home program for the time period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, this additional amount was not included in the FY 2021-2022 Adopted Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, it appears in the best interests of the County, its residents, and other customers to accept the awarded funds; and

**WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 29130 provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

**NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, THAT:**

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The HHS Budget for FY 2021-2022 is amended as follows:
